OUTLINE OF PLAYING RULES



1. All games will be 5-a-side.
2. Teams will be in squads of 6 – may go to 7.
3. Players will have the opportunity to play in two games.
4. All players are entitled to half a game in both games regardless of ability.
5. Each team may field four outfield players and a goalkeeper on the pitch at any time.
6. Substitutions can only be made during half time in both games.
7. A change of goalkeeper must be authorized by the referee.
8. Only training shoes/moulded astro boots may be worn. No screw-in studs.
9. Match Length: 30 minutes (12.5 minutes each way, 5 minutes changeover at half time).
10. Each half will begin with one team taking a centre. After a goal has been scored the game will be re-started in a similar manner.
11. Only the defending goalkeeper is allowed to play the ball inside the goal area and only he may handle the ball in this area.

ALL PLAYERS MUST WEAR SHIN PADS.

12. A goalkeeper gaining or seeking to gain an advantage by leaving his area or by playing the ball when it is outside the area will cause a penalty to be awarded against his team.

OUTLINE OF PLAYING RULES

13. The goalkeeper must return the ball into play by rolling it out of his area with an under-arm bowling action
14. The ball must not be played above kick board height.



15. The ball must never be played with the head even if it is below board height. A free kick will be awarded for infringement.
16. A goal may be scored from any point within the field of play. The only exception is that goalkeepers may not score against their opponents.
17. No slide tackles are allowed. Infringement of this rule will lead to an indirect free kick being awarded against the offending player's team.
18. Free kicks for fouls are direct. All other free kicks are indirect. Observe the referees signal. Opposition players must be at least five feet from where any free kick is taken.
19. Players may only take one step before striking penalty kicks.



The decision of the referee in all matters pertaining to the playing rules of an individual game is final
